

## CCSP/TCC Information

### for Parents and Guardians

**Summary:** This guidance document serves as a resource to help you determine if you may be eligible for Transitional Child Care or the Child Care Subsidy Program.

### **Transitional Child Care**

(TCC)

#### 1. Are you a former TANF recipient?

- Received TANF in the last 12 months, or been open TCC in the last 30 days?
- Did you have earnings at the time TANF closed?
- Are you working now?

If "yes" to all, go to question #2. If "no" to any, go to question #3.

# 2. Is your income below 250% Federal Poverty Level (FPL)?

(CCSP)

#### 3. Are you a parent who is:

- Working;
- In school;
- In a job training program; or
- A guardian that is the age of 65 with retirement documentation?

If "yes" to any, go to question #4.

If "no" to all, not eligible for the Child Care Subsidy Program.

# 4. Is your income at or below 85% of the State Median Income (SMI)?
