FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where are the productions?

Madagascar will be performed at the Carousel Music Theater. Elf, Shrek, and Lion King will be performed at the Lincoln Theater. The Little Mermaid will be performed in the YMCA Annex.

Why are some of the performances before the session ends?

For our 2 week campers, we hold a day of Theater Camp Olympics for their last day. This serves as a celebration of all the hard work they put in on their show.

Where does camp take place?

Y Arts Camps take place on the Boothbay YMCA Campus, mostly in the Annex. For 2 week camps with production at Lincoln Theater, two full days will be spent in Damariscotta at the theater.

Are there costumes for the shows?

We do not do full costumes for the summer productions but we do add costume pieces and props to enhance the performance.

Will campers need anything for performances?

All campers will be asked to wear black bottoms (skirt, pants, shorts) and black shoes for the performance.

What should campers bring to camp each day?

Full Day– Snacks (morning and afternoon), lunch, water bottle, bathing suit, towel, change of clothes, closed toe shoes

Show Only or 1/2 day– Snack, water bottle, closed toe shoes

Will campers audition for roles in the show?

On the first day of each session, campers will audition for specific roles in the given show. The director, Emily Mirabile, will then cast the show and give out scripts on that same day. Rehearsals will also begin on the first day of the session.

It is important to not miss rehearsals.
